

Thanks to Eric Marshall from Australia who discovered the pair on the 1901 Census, it turns out that [Winifred](#) and [Kathleen](#) Boxshall were the daughters of [Frank Arkwell Boxshall](#) and [Annie Helena Chamberlain](#) who married in 1891, the marriage being registered in Woolwich, London. In 1901 the family were living in Epsom, Surrey and in 1911 Kingston, Surrey.

[Frank Arwell Boxshall](#) was the son of [Thomas Boxshall](#) and [Mary Ann Arkwell](#) who married on 27 Nov 1860 in Lambeth, London.

[Annie Helena](#) was the daughter of [John](#) and [Hannah](#) Chamberlain and it was her sister [Mary Ann Letitia Chamberlain](#) who married [Henry Thomas Weeks](#).

This makes the Boxshall sisters to be Helen Williams (nee Lambert) first cousins twice removed.
